

## CURRENT PRESCHOOL (VPK) STUDENTS

Our preschool graduation is tentatively scheduled for **Friday, May 18, 2012**. The children will perform a program followed by presentation of diplomas and the infamous "Pomp and Circumstance".

Please provide a picture of your soon-to-be Preschool Graduate as an infant or toddler. We will be using these photos for a special entry in the yearbook. All photos must be submitted no later than **Friday, March 15th**, in order to make our publishing deadline.

Individual cap and gown photographs of all our graduates will be taken on **Tuesday, March 6th**. Please remember that caps will be worn when fixing child's hair that day. Although clothing will not be seen under their gowns, please refrain from collared shirts. Shoes will not be visible in the photograph.

The VPK funding and last day for part time students (Ms. Beth/Ms. Maria's Class) is **June 6th**. The VPK funding will end **Friday, May 4th** for full time students (4A,4B,4C).

Effective **Monday, May 7th**, the weekly tuition will be **\$140.00**. If your child is a full time student, we **DO NOT** automatically assume that you will be withdrawing your child from our program when the VPK funding ceases. We ask that you provide a written notification no later than **March 30th** if you intend to do so. Due to rehearsal and the nature of the graduation ceremony, if your child does not remain enrolled through the graduation date, they will not be allowed to participate.

If you will not be needing Before/After School care this fall, please inform us in writing by **March 30th**. This will assist us in transportation planning. Care for summer, school holidays and breaks **ONLY** for elementary students is also available. Details in office. Please refer to page one for more information regarding fall enrollment.

We will keep you posted regarding information about enrolling your child for kindergarten when received.

## SCHOOL AGE CHILDREN

The last day of school for our school-age children is **Friday, June 6th**.

We have plans to keep your children busy and happy all summer long. Various activities and outings will be planned. More information will follow with applicable details.

The weekly tuition for school-aged children during summer break is \$130. During the summer, school-age children will only be charged for the actual days of attendance at \$26.00 per day. The cost of the field trips will be extra.

If you will not be requiring services during the summer months, we would appreciate your informing us **in writing** no later than **March 30th**.

If your child has a sibling that is not currently enrolled and will require services for the summer months, please submit an Application for Enrollment accompanied by a registration fee of \$37.50 by **March 30th**.
