SPECIAL EDITION VOLUNTARY PREKINDERGARTEN

If your child will be four (4) on or before September 1, 2012 (born between 09/02/07 and 09/01/08), you qualify for the Voluntary Prekindergarten Program for the 2012-2013 school year.

Parents of children in Classrooms 3B, and 3C this means you!

We will be holding a meeting **Tuesday, March 27 at 6:30 PM**. Attendance of at least one parent is **MANDATORY**. Invaluable information will be shared regarding Florida's Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program and reduction in your weekly tuition.

WHAT IS VOLUNTARY PREKINDERGARTEN?

Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) is available to all Florida four-year olds. VPK programs utilize learning through play, developmentally appropriate instruction and activities, and approved VPK providers to prepare your child to be ready to learn upon entering kindergarten.

All children who live in Florida who turn 4 years of age by September 1st of the program year are eligible to participate in Florida's VPK program, including children with disabilities.
